Geometers Sketchpad is a drawing, animation, and measurement program created by the Geometer's SketchPad team at Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). The text-based interface makes it easy for kids to learn geometry - no computer skills are needed. It's also great for experimenting with math concepts that are difficult to visualize in 2-dimensions, like graphing the cosine function or using complex numbers.

There has never been a better time to download Geometers Sketchpad 5.05! In honor of Geometers Sketchpad's 50th anniversary, you can download a fully functional version of Geometers Sketchpad for free from the Geometers Sketchpad website. The only limitation is that you cannot save your work in this version, but there is a special link in the program to grant you full access to all features and tutorials every time you launch the program. For teachers, this is a great opportunity to introduce geometry and mathematical concepts using Geometers Sketchpad in your classroom.

Then, the next time you launch the program, you'll be prompted to enter an activation code. When you do, you'll have full access to all tutorials and features of Geometers Sketchpad.
